



News and new wines from the Domaine de Bourdic

Alignan du Vent, 2. 12. 2007

In spring, our first-ever white wines will be ready for drinking. The winter chill has given them a crystal clarity, and they will be bottled during the month of February.

We are currently in the middle of developing a new range of wines.

Up until now we have grown a **single grape** range such as Tempranillo, Granache, Syrah and Merlot, and the more **traditional** varieties in blends such as La Sentinelle, Le Puech, and Le Hortalesse. We are returning to our own roots, and also creating a **musical** range. Wines which resonate and give pleasure to the senses, and which are designed to be consumed sooner rather than later.

These wines will be named after composers who have played an important role in Hans' life as a musician.

Our first choice goes to [Edgar Varèse](#) (1885 - 1965), a French composer who emigrated to the United States. He led an uncompromising life on the margins of society, among the creators of the musical avant-garde and he is still under-valued on the musical scene.

Please find enclosed a list of our 2008 prices. Even if everything around us is increasing in price, we have decided to keep to the 2007 prices. We are also offering our new wines at highly competitive promotional rates.

We hope our new wines will meet your highest expectations, and we are happy to answer any other queries you may have.

Density 2007

A duet of white grapes, composed of 60% Roussanne and 40% Vermentino. These two varieties were already being put together during the grape picking season. The full maturity of the Roussanne grapes gives the wine the rich aroma, whilst the Vermentino lends it a crisp, dry piquancy.

Octandre 2007

A delightful red. This octet follows the proportions of [Fibonacci](#) and is mainly composed of Cinsault, but also of Grenache, Tempranillo, Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet, Vermentino and Roussanne.

And last, but by no means least, a new white wine who is in the single grape range

Muscat 2007

Dry, fruity, and typically Muscat in flavour. As there are very few bottles being made - only 600 - we recommend that you order some early!
